<b>Furniture and furnishings:</b> Ensure that 30% of the annual furnishings and furniture purchases (based on cost) eliminate the use of priority chemicals of concern by FY2025.	Furniture and furnishings overview
<b>PVC and DEHP:</b> Eliminate both PVC and DEHP from at least 2 of 8 priority medical product categories defined above (see Part III: Definitions) by FY2025.	Position statement
<b>Sustainable food:</b> Achieve 20% of total food purchases meeting sustainable criteria by FY2025 (measure=dollars).	Sustainable food overview
Greening the OR: Reduce single-use, disposable products to reusable products: Transition single-use, disposable products to reusable products in 5 of the 10 supply categories on the checklist (see Part III: Definitions) by FY2025. The goal is qualitative by identifying which are transitioned from disposable to reusable.	Reusable products overview
