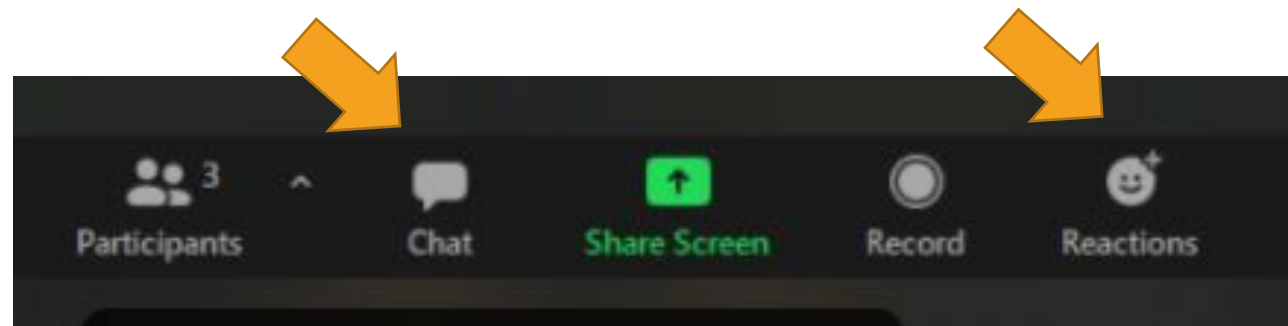

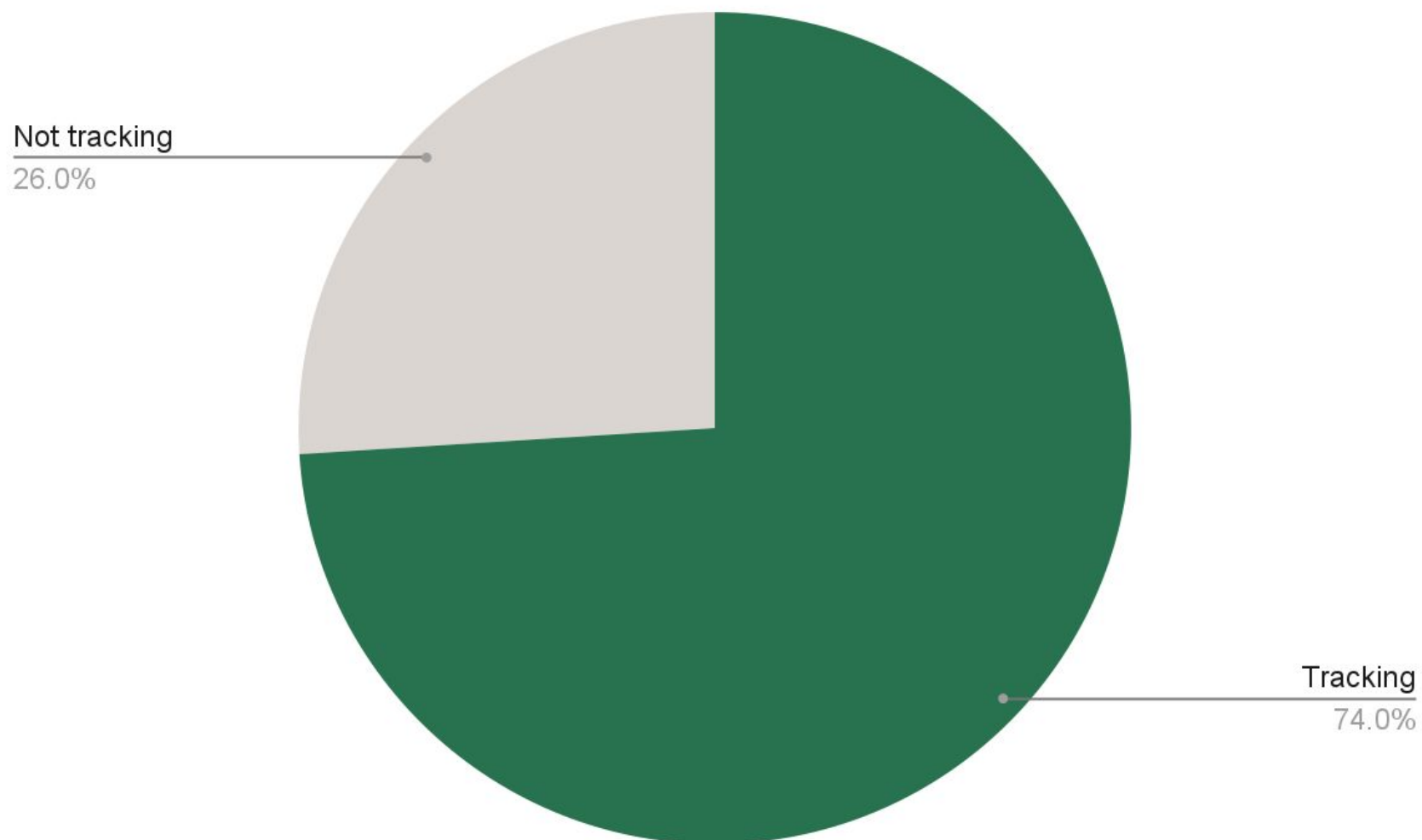

- Donated and salvaged materials
- Computer equipment
- Food-related: local and sustainable spend
- Furniture, furnishings
- Office products
- Lighting
- Renewable energy
- Reprocessing (collections/buy-back)
- Third party ecolabels
  - U.S. EPA's: Energy Star, WaterSense, Safer Choice
  - Green Seal, UL Ecologo
  - Forest Stewardship Council (FSC)
  - UL GreenGuard
  - EPEAT

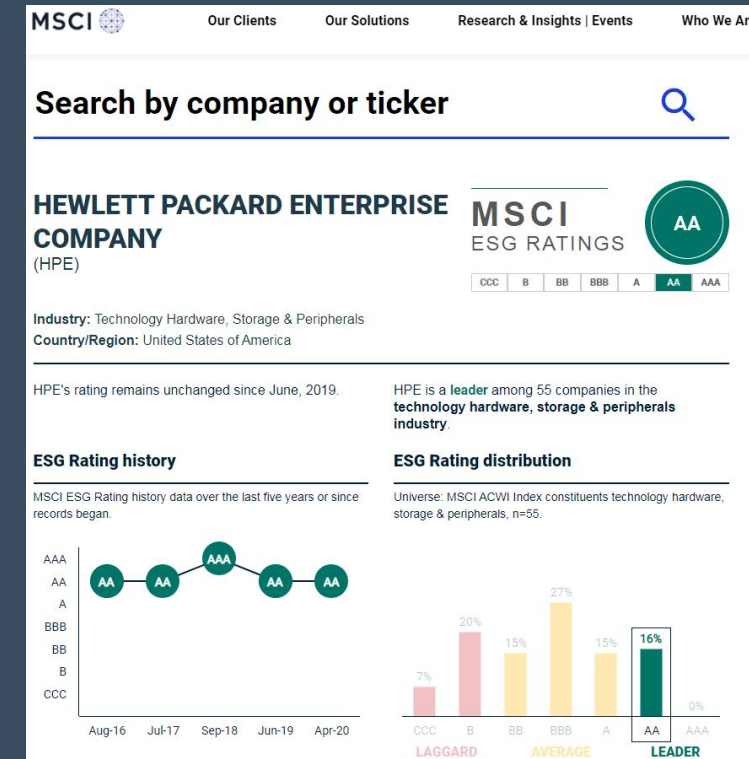
- Supply Chain RFI/RFP Sustainability/ESG questions

# Supplier Engagement Strategies

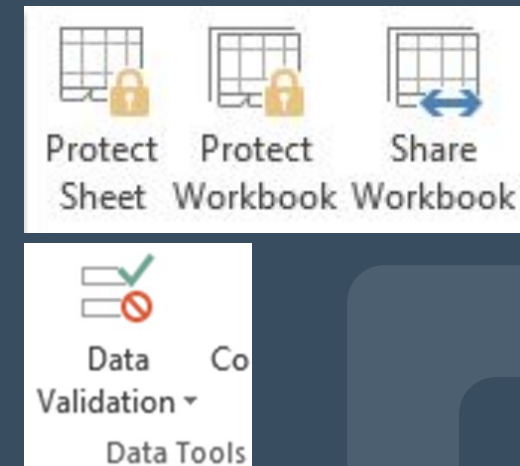
## Spend Data

- Determine who is handling the data request
  - Include their supervisor in communications?
- Give reasonable due date and verify if it is achievable
  - Vacations? Competing project deadlines?
- Be clear about exactly what data is required and how granular it should be
  - By facility? kWh/MWh/GWh? Spend? Volume? SKUs? Time frame?
  - What to exclude – Installation, shipping, handling, etc.
  - Data request frequency – Annually/Quarterly/Monthly

# Supplier Engagement Strategies

## Spend Data

- Add language to contracts requiring data reporting
- Provide an easy to use excel template and walk them through it
- Utilize features on Excel's "Data" and "Review" tabs
  - "Data Validation" limits supplier's input data to maintain consistency
  - Apply "Share/Protect Workbook" functions
- Validate against previous data

# Add sustainable purchasing requirements in contracts

Specify sustainability requirements and communicate them to potential suppliers using key sections of sourcing/contracting.



# Solution opportunities - August cohort call

Solution #1: Integrate language into contracts (add a clause “you are required to provide data”)

Solution #2: Provide a template to vendors for data collection in excel

Solution #3: Focus on a limited set of categories to start

Solution #4: Build relationships with suppliers and GPOs to make it easier
