Seattle Children's Rooftop Garden

Seattle Children's has a large campus with a huge variety of plant and tree specimens. When our 2013 Building Hope was planned, one wing of the top floor was devoted to garden spaces. The plan includes a healing garden space for cancer patients and their families as our Cancer Care unit is adjacent to the



space. Next to the healing garden we placed a large rooftop garden to mitigate stormwater runoff.

The plantings are native or drought tolerant, and there are typical Pacific NW design elements like raw wood benches.

Both staff and families use the space and it affords wonderful views of the neighborhood and Lake Washington.
