### 2015 Paper Reduction Results and New Goals

Seattle Children's reduced paper usage by 3% per adjusted patient day in 2015, which means that while we were busier in 2015, our paper usage did not increase. Thanks to all who made this happen. The 2016 paper reduction goal is to do it again – here's how you can help:

- Eliminate two print jobs this month
- Send print jobs to your large multifunction printer, which six to seven times less expensive than printing on smaller printers due to toner costs
- Have a paperless meeting by sending your handouts or agendas ahead of time for meeting attendees to review
