


Practice Greenhealth Membership

Demonstrating the growing commitment among the health community to reduce its environmental impact, Practice Greenhealth membership continues to expand, now representing 1,000+ member hospitals nationwide – approximately 20% of the hospitals in the U.S. Of the top *U.S. News & World Report* listing of the best hospitals in the country, two-thirds are members of Practice Greenhealth. Practice Greenhealth is a learning community working toward the greening of health care, offering the next generation of tools and services that can take organizations, wherever they are on the continuum, to the next level of sustainability excellence.

Practice Greenhealth offers a variety of programs to its members, including the Health care Clean Energy Exchange, Greenhealth Academy, *Greenhealth* magazine and the weekly Greenhealth eNews, discounts on the CleanMed Conference & Exposition, the Sustainability Benchmark Report, environmental purchasing, sustainable operations, continuing education, webinars, networking opportunities, communications, and an annual Environmental Excellence Awards program recognizing the achievements of member institutions.

Beyond helping members establish goals and best practices, Practice Greenhealth provides specific tools, education and assistance in reaching those goals. For example, we host more than 35 webinars each year through Greenhealth Academy[™], free to our member participants. Among many other resources, members have access to step-by-step guides and our Energy Impact Calculator, and receive discounts on tools such as the Greenhealth Sustainability Dashboard and the Greenhealth Tracker[™].

Practice Greenhealth member hospitals are achieving dramatic reductions in their environmental footprints with, to name just a few areas: significant overall waste reduction practices, and diverting waste into recycling and more sustainable waste streams (a percentage of otherwise solid waste tonnage becomes recycled). In addition, our member hospitals have made dramatic strides in the elimination of mercury and DEPH. They are achieving reductions in both supplyside energy costs and demand-side energy use. Our members are also implementing practices to give preference to the purchase of environmentally preferable products.
