What to Recycle: Computers, laptops, cell phones, tablets, TV's, monitors, digital picture frames, printers, copiers, keyboards, mice, stereo equipment, hard-drives, DVD/CD players, phones, paper shredders, and fax machines.

Why: Electronics contain toxic materials

like heavy metals that can harm both the environment and human health. Heavy metals can cause many health problems including seizures, lung cancer, and kidney damage. For this reason, throwing away electronics with ordinary trash is banned in New Hampshire and Vermont to prevent heavy metals from getting into the water supply. Recycling your electronics at a certified e-cycler ensures your old laptop won't end up in a landfill or another country, causing environmental and health problems for future generations.
